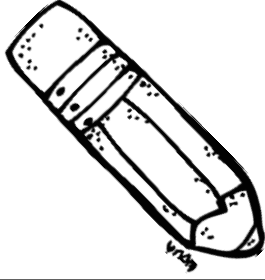
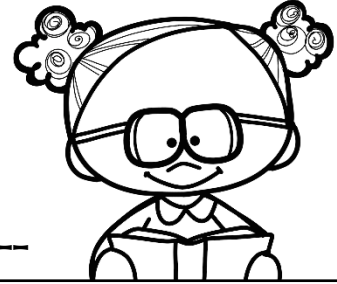

Conduct a fictional interview with a character from this book. Write at least 10 question and answers for the character.

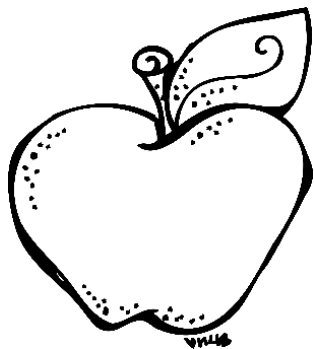
BOOK REVIEW

Write a review for the book you read. What did you like and dislike? What would you change? Would you recommend it?

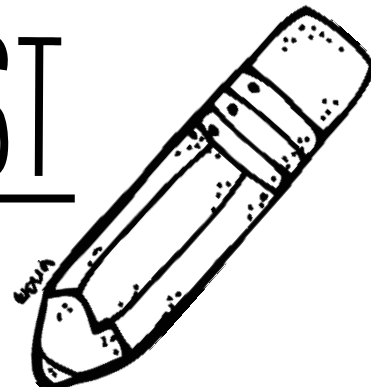
